Nominations are needed for the faculty senate president. The ABET 30-day response is due on 03/27/2019. The SBHE has approved the move of Computer Science into the College of Engineering and it will be effective on July 01, 2019. From the meeting with President Bresciani funding for the two buildings look good and if things go well, the engineering building will be the next on the list. Students from our civil engineering department won the steel bridge competition at the regional level. The next level of competition will be at the University of Illinois later in the year.
