- Dean Kessler informs the faculties about a core proposal (\$15M) that involves eight institutions in the great plains to train STEM students in commercializing promising technologies
- The CoE is also working with one university in Saudi Arabia in developing a transfer (2+2) program for undergraduate degrees, currently focusing on mechanical & industrial engineering. As the job market is good for employees, the CoE is facing difficulty to fill up the opening positions. In addition, the CoE is also short of staffs. Two Assistant Professor of Practice positions for IME and CME have been advertised and being filled.
- Associate Dean Pryor updates on the current state of enrolment for the College. Despite
 of the increase in incoming freshmen in comparison to last year, the number of enrolling
 students decreases as we have a record graduating class. We will make all efforts in
 recruiting and retaining CoE students.
- Dr. Glower informs the faculties on the teaching achievements of leading contributors:
 - Dr. Ali Amiri (ME) who was on a 4+4 teaching load in 2021, produced 1595 SCH, and generated \$543,895 in tuition and fees through these courses.
 - Dr. Michael Maassel (ECE) who was on a 4+5 teaching load in 2021, produced 1199 SCH, and generated \$408,859 in tuition and fees through these courses,
 - Dr. Oksana Myronovych (CIS) who was on a 4+3 teaching load in 2021, produced
 930 SCH, and generated \$317,930 in tuition and fees through these courses, and
 - Dr. David Grewell (IME) who was on a 3+3 teaching load in 2021, produced 909
 SCH, and generated \$309,969 in tuition and fees through these courses,
